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May 2016

Fri 13: Australia to Kuching - we fly with Singapore Airlines to Kuching. Hilton Kuching (2 nights)

Sat 14: Kuching City and River Tour - our day starts with a 3 hour private walking tour that covers Kuching's Chinatown, Civic Centre viewing Platform and the Sarawak Museum. We then take a 1 hour boat tour to view the city from the river.

Sat 15: Kuching (B) - in the morning we visit the Sarawak Cultural Village which is nestled in the foothills of Mount Santubong. The seven authentic traditional buildings are set amidst a scenic 17 acre site populated by members of Sarawak's many ethnic groups going about their daily activities. These include wood and bamboo carving, beadwork and weaving.

Mon 16: Kuching to Batang Ai (B/L/D) - after leaving Kuching, we drive through tropical rainforest interspersed with paddy fields, pepper gardens and rubber plantations. Our final destination for the day is the superb Aiman Batang Ai Resort where the modern accommodation is built in the style of longhouses. Aiman Batang Ai Resort (2 nights)

Tue 17: Batang Ai - in the morning we visit one of the local communities that still live in traditional longhouses along the Lemanak River. In the afternoon there a variety of activities which are also available at the property.

Wed 18: Batang Ai to Kuching (B/L) - we visit some of the local villages on our leisurely drive back to Kuching. Hilton Kuching (1 night)

Thu 19: Kuching to Kota Kinabalu (B) - we fly with Malaysia Airlines to Kota Kinabalu. Horizon Hotel (3 nights)

Fri 20: Kota Kinabalu (B/L) - today we have a chance to prepare and sample the local food. We visit a market to purchase the ingredients for our meal. A local resident cook then take us to their own house where we prepare our lunch of locally prized dishes.


Sat 21: North Borneo Railway (B/L) - we board the historic North Borneo Railway at the Tanjung Aru Station and travel through to Papar. On the ride we experience the days of the British Colonial Office, when people traveled by steam train into the heart of Sabah. We soak in the green vistas of sprawling paddy fields, traditional village homes on stilts and buffaloes ambling in the distance.

Sun 22: Kota Kinabalu to Kinabalu National Park (B/L/D) - in the morning we travel to Kota Belu and visit the Sunday Market. We then visit the Kundasang War Memorial Park to learn about Sabah's WWII history. We continue travel to Kinabalu Park, one of the world's most important biological sites. Zen Garden Resort (1 night)

Mon 23: Kundasang to Sandakan (B/L) - we continue overland to Sandakan. Sepilok Nature Resort (2 nights)

Tue 24: Sandakan (B/L) - in the morning we tour the world famous Sepilok Rehabilitation Centre to witness the feeding of the orang utans. In the afternoon we tour the Rainforest Discovery Centre.

Wed 25: Sandakan to Sukau Rainforest Lodge (B/L/D) - morning tour to Sandakan War Memorial and then we take a two and half hour boat journey up the Kintabangan River to the award winning Sukau Rainforest Lodge (2 nights)



Thu 26: Sukau Rainforest Lodge (B/L/D) - we take early morning and late afternoon wildlife viewing cruises. The region is home to all 8 species of hornbill and the highest concentration of orang utans and proboscis monkeys in the wild.

Fri 27: Sukau Rainforest Lodge to Borneo Rainforest Lodge (B/L/D) - we travel to the Gomantong Caves for a short visit before continuing overland to Lahad Datu. In the afternoon there is a 2 hour drive to the beautiful Borneo Rainforest Lodge. The property is nestled in a magnificent setting alongside the Danum River. Borneo Rainforest Lodge (2 nights)

Sat 28: Borneo Rainforest Lodge (B/L/D) - during the day we explore the forest for birds and mammals. You can also trek to the waterfall for a dip in the rock pools.

Sun 29: Borneo Rainforest Lodge to Kota Kinabalu (B/L) - we transfer by road to Lahad Datu and then fly back to Kota Kinabalu. Horizon Hotel (1 night)

Mon 30: Kota Kinabalu to Singapore to Australia (B) - we fly to Singapore and continue to Australia.

Tue 31: Australia - morning arrival into Australia.
